



Elder Law Attorneys

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There are several elder law attorneys in the greater Austin area who can assist families with end-of-life issues such as wills, trusts, power of attorney, estate preservation, and other services. They may offer a free initial phone/visit consultation to assess if they would be of help to you and your family. Elder law attorneys can also assist with Skilled Nursing Medicaid to conserve family financials if needed (by developing qualified income trusts, etc.). You may also find it helpful to meet with a local skilled nursing facility admissions coordinator to discuss the process for facility long-term care and Medicaid.

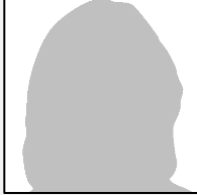
